

Grants.Gov How to Get Started on a MAC

Before you begin using www.grants.gov you'll need to install an application on your computer. In the MAC OS X environment you'll need the Pure Edge Viewer package for Macintosh OS X. This software package is required to complete and submit applications electronically.

To get started:

Open your browser and go to www.grants.gov

- Click the link titled **Get Started**
- Scroll towards the bottom and look for the section titled **Apply for Grants**.
- Click on **download PureEdge Viewer**.

Apply for Grants

Once you have located a grant opportunity for which you wish to apply, check to see if it is available to apply online through Grants.gov. You will need to enter the Funding Opportunity and/or CFDA number to access the application package and instructions. In order to view application packages and instructions, you will also need to download and install the [PureEdge Viewer](#).

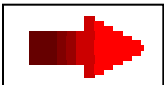

As a part of our ongoing commitment to releasing new features and site enhancements, Grants.gov is proud to partner with NIH (National Institutes of Health) to launch Citrix server availability for all users.

Beginning December 20, 2005, non-Windows users will be able to download and complete the PureEdge forms by taking advantage of the free Citrix server. Non-Windows users are also able to submit completed grant applications via the Citrix environment. Instructions are provided below on how to use the Citrix server functionality.

Macintosh System Requirements:

1. OS X Version 10.1, 10.2, 10.3, or 10.4.
2. 128 MB of RAM
3. 10 MB Disk Space
4. PowerPC Processor

Click on **Download the Citrix Package for Macintosh OS X users**.

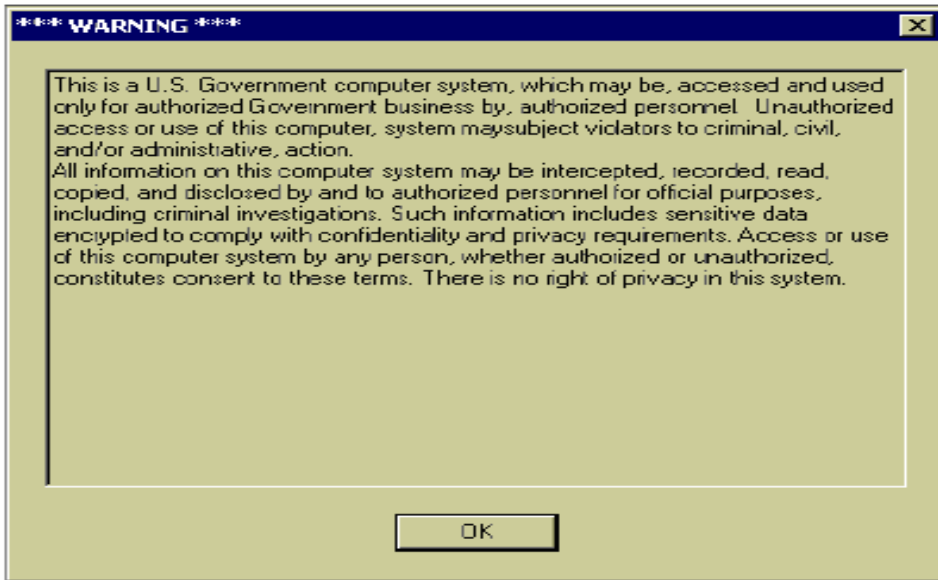
An icon titled Grants.gov 1.0.3g.dmg should appear on your desktop.



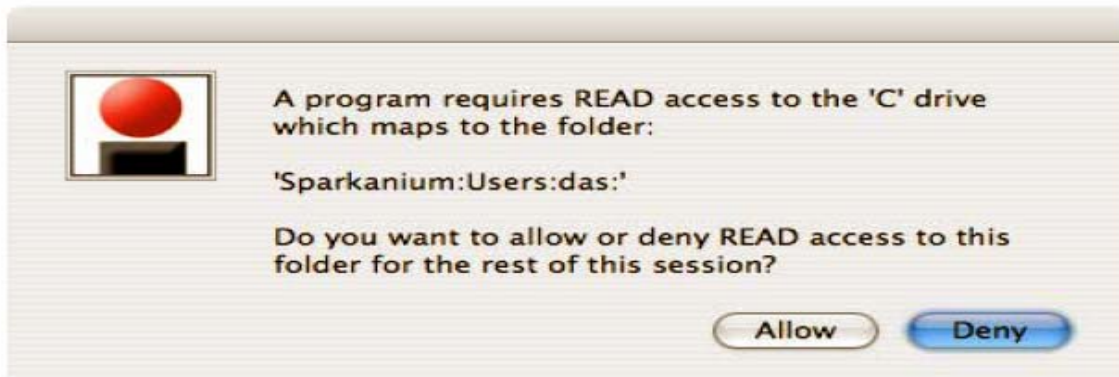
Double click the icon and the Grants.gov Citrix package will open. If the link does not open double click on the Grants.gov for Mac OS X icon on your desktop.



A warning message will appear – you must click **OK** to accept the message and continue.



You must allow the application read access to your PC to continue.



You should now be logged onto the Grants.gov Citrix Server.
