Effective 1 July 2007, all main campus compliance personnel were consolidated in one unit under Dr. Tim. J. Ward, Assistant Vice President for Research and Interim Director of Research Compliance, Main Campus. Professor Ward is responsible for research compliance on the main campus connected with conflicts of interest, animal care and use, human subjects, and research ethics and conduct. In addition, he is responsible for oversight of export control issues when these are accepted by the University.

Along with oversight on the day-to-day operation of these compliance functions, Dr. Ward is reviewing staffing levels and functions, current processes and procedures, and funding levels in order to develop the correct mix and level of services from the OVPRED . In addition, he is charged with developing a new Web site for the all compliance functions under his purview.
